The following facilities available at the College is used for a better curriculum transaction:

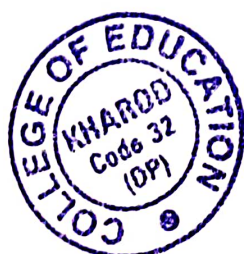
