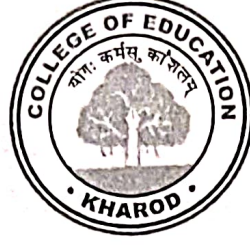

Title: Creating “Hast-Likhit Ank” (Handwritten Magazine) – **Theme:** Ancient Rishis (Indian Knowledge System)

1. Objectives:

- To familiarize pre-service teachers with the contributions of ancient Rishis to Philosophy, science etc.
- To integrate traditional Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) into modern teacher education.
- To revive the art of handwriting and calligraphy in an increasingly digital world.
- To develop research skills as students look for historical data on ancient scholars.
- To foster an aesthetic sense through manual illustration and creative page design.

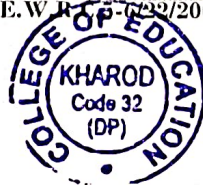
2. Context: The College of Education, Kharod, aims to produce teachers who are not only technologically savvy but also rooted in Indian heritage. By choosing the theme of **Ancient Rishis**, the college encourages students to explore the roots of Indian wisdom—ranging from *Ayurveda* and *Astronomy* to *Grammar* and *Yoga*—ensuring that future educators can pass this cultural legacy to the next generation.

3. The Practice:

- **Thematic Orientation:** The Library Committee held sessions introducing students to great Indian minds like **Aryabhata, Sushruta, Charaka, Panini, and Shakuntala Devi**.
- **Research & Drafting:** Students researched specific sages in the library to write original articles and draw portraits highlighting their relevance to modern education.
- **Handcrafted Execution:** Every page was meticulously handwritten and decorated with **Sanskrit Shlokas**, artistic borders, and relevant photos to maintain an authentic IKS feel.
- **Compilation:** After reviewing for historical and linguistic accuracy, the committee artistically bound the contributions into a permanent volume for the college archives.

4. Evidence of Success: The 2024-25 volume of *Hast-Likhit Ank* is prominently displayed in the college library and Exhibition on teacher day.

5. Problems: Students faced challenges in sourcing verified historical data on ancient sages and struggled with the patience required for high-quality manual calligraphy. To resolve this, the library provided specialized **IKS reference books** while faculty members conducted sessions on **layout design** to improve the magazine's aesthetic quality.

Practice:
